DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO WILL ROGERS MEMORIAL CENTER

FROM THE NORTH...Take I-35W south to downtown Fort Worth – Exit I-30 west towards Abilene – Travel approximately three miles past downtown Fort Worth to the Montgomery Street Exit (Exit 11) – Turn north (right) on Montgomery Street.

FROM THE SOUTH...Take I-35W north to downtown Fort Worth – Exit I-30 west towards Abilene – Travel approximately three miles past downtown Fort Worth to the Montgomery Street Exit (Exit 11) – Turn north (right) on Montgomery Street.

FROM THE EAST...Take I-30 west approximately three miles past downtown Fort Worth to the Montgomery Street Exit (Exit 11) – Turn north (right) on Montgomery Street.

FROM THE WEST...Take I-30 east to the Montgomery Street Exit (Exit 11) – Turn north (left) on Montgomery Street.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

THE FORT WORTH KENNEL CLUB, INC. reserves the right to use additional buildings or space within the Will Rogers Center should the entry warrant it.

Beginning May, 2010, the city of Fort Worth has implemented a parking fee for vehicles that park in the WRMC Complex. Exhibitors will be able to purchase a multi-day parking pass which will allow in and out access. The fee for 2017 is \$10 per day.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 12:00 noon Thursday, March 23, 2017. The club reserves the right to alter this time depending on weather conditions and/or other condition of the building. Unloading will be supervised by members of the Club or their designated representatives, to insure orderly access to the building. All dogs must be removed from the show site by one hour following the completion of Best in Show on Sunday, March 26, 2017.

NO SOFT CRATES

GENERAL

Exhibitors are expected to comply with all Club rules as laid out and enforced by the Fort Worth Kennel Club, Inc.

Dogs may not be exercised outside the show building on the grass or sidewalks or paved parking lots of Will Rogers complex, the Museum or the Art Center.

All groups will be judged in the Large Exhibit Building and may be judged two at a time.

All catalog will be sold. None will be given away.

Dogs must not be tied to bushes shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

The Fort Worth Kennel Club, Inc. Show Superintendent or the City of Fort Worth will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the show buildings or the rounds at Will Rogers Complex.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

A night watchman will be on duty Thursday through Saturday night as a courtesy only.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when exercising.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office must be advised at once. The Superintendents and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside the building.

The Fort Worth Kennel Club, Inc. is no responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

There will be no space provided for un-entered dogs at this show.

GROOMING AND CRATING

PLEASE NOTE: The grooming area in the Large Exhibit Building will be **CLOSED** to additional crates, equipment, etc. when the Show Committee determines the area to be full. Additional space is available in the Sheep and Seine Barns.

The grooming areas and crate set up in the Large Exhibit Building will be handled in the following manner:

A member of the Show Committee will direct every exhibitor with the EXACT placement of their crates, grooming tables, etc. for their area. EACH designated grooming space will be split length ways down the middle with tape. All crates will be placed in IDENTICAL FASHION, as directed by the Show Committee.

Crating is not allowed in the Small Exhibits Building. Water, electrical outlets and grooming space, including washing areas, are available in Sheep and Swine Barns.

Crating and grooming areas are allotted on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED** basis. No crating area inside any building may be reserved or saved by roping off, placing cones, chairs, tables, equipment or any other means you may think to employ.

No crate or grooming tables will be allowed at ringside in the Large Exhibits Building, but there will be a designated area for crates and tables between the rings.

The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of grooming tables and to rearrange grooming areas and set ups as required circumstances for the safety and convenience of all. **THIS INCLUDES MOVING CRATES, TABLES AND OTHER EQUIPMENT**

ALL CRATES, INCLUDING WIRE CRATES MUST BE STACKED.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

No rugs or mats are allowed in the grooming area.

Ringside chairs are not to be taken to the grooming area.

Absolutely NO private exercise pens will be allowed in the Large Exhibits Building at any time.

Public exercise pens will be provided and must be attended by owner or handler while in use

Crates may not be set up in the west lot or in the area north of the building. All private exercise pens outside the building must be areas designated by the Club.

No dogs or crates are allowed in the underground garage.

No private chairs at ringside.

PARKING REGULATIONS

Parking to unload: 20 minutes only. Violators are subject to being ticketed and towed.

No RV or trailer parking in the lot to the west of the Large Exhibits Building. There are RV hookups and a dump station in the south of Harley and Montgomery Street and in the area next to the Swine Building. **Contact Will Rogers Memorial Center, Am Carter Square, Fort Worth, Texas 76107—817-871-8150 for information and payment. ALL VEHICLES LARGER THAN THE STANDARD VAN MUST PARK IN THE LOTS ONE BLOCK SOUTH OF THE MUSEUM OF SCIENCE AND HISTORY** on Harley/Montgomery. The area next to the Swine Building is paid RV parking ONLY. RV lots on Harley Street and west of the Swine Building will have water and hookups. No water or hookups in Rip Johnson lot.

RV Parking is on a first come first served basis and is handled directly by WRMC. **RV SPACES WILL BE INVOICED TO EXHIBITORS AT THE PREVAILING RATE FOR 30-AMP OR 50-AMP SERVICE. BASED UPON AVAILABILITY.**

NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CONCOURSE AREA EXCEPT ON DESIGNATED MATTED AREAS.

Loading and un-loading is permitted at the north end of the Large Exhibit Building on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the north entrance of the building and from the west parking lot in the area of the steps leading to the north entrance.

Loading and un-loading of dogs is permitted in the south side of the Small Exhibits Building and between the Swine and Sheep barns.

Parking on marked lots will have to be inside the designated lines. No vehicles will be permitted to extend into the fire lanes. No single vehicle will be permitted to occupy more than one space.

All parking will be on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED** basis. Spaces may not be saved.

Positively no dumping of drain or holding tanks. Filing of water tanks from any source on the Will Rogers Complex will not be permitted.

The Show Committee reserves the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Violations of these parking regulations will be prosecuted and vehicles towed away, at the owners expense without notice.

EXTENSION CORD REQUIREMENTS

THE CITY OF FORT WORTH ENFORCES THE 1996 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE TO ENSURE THE PUBLIC IS NOT EXPOSED TO ELECTRICAL HAZARDS. THIS CODE HAS SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TYPE OF EXTENSION CORDS THAT MAY BE USED AND HOW THEY ARE USED.

If extension cords are used at the Will Rogers Memorial Complex, **Ground Fault Circuit Interrupt Protection (GFCI)** is required. This cord is sold at most building and electrical supply stores. These cords are easily recognized as they have a test and a reset button on the cord. Most of these cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on the cord. All 120-volt extension cords shall be three wired grounding type cords (recognized by the three prong plug at the end of the cord). Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways. These requirements will help eliminate harmful or fatal electrical hazards to you and/or your animals.

City staff, including Fire Inspectors and Electrical Inspectors will check the premises from time to time for your compliance. Your cooperation is appreciated.

NOTICE

All rights to TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Clubs, or in persons to whom such rights have been made in writing by the Clubs. All persons and animals on the Showgrounds at any time while the Show is in progress, do by attending these shows or participate therein, grant to the Clubs the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

A RECORDING FEE OF .50 CENTS FOR EACH DOG AND AN AKC EVENT FEE OF \$3.00 WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EACH RECORDABLE SINGLE ENTRY CLASS AT ANY LICENSED OR MEMBER CLUB SHOW OR OBEDIENCE TRIAL. (AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULE, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 2). AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF \$3.50 1ST ENTRY AND \$3.00 ADDITIONAL ENTRY OF SAME DOG WILL BE REQUIRED FOR WCH ENTRY IN RALLY. (AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RALLY REGULATION CHAPTER 1, SECTION 3). THESE FEES WILL BE PAID TO THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for schedules judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen, and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or to be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damaged or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signature or the "agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. **Those received by telephone are not acceptable.**

Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

An administration fee of \$2.00 will be charged for any cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
